The university is taking new, strategic steps to improve our collective web presence by reducing the number of public facing NMSU websites and moving websites needed for internal use or university business operations behind a single sign-on/firewall environment for access. The platform the university has selected for public facing sites is Cascade and WordPress will continue to be used for internal facing sites.

In alignment with NMSU LEADS 2025 and in order to support NMSU's success across all disciplines and to advance research, scholarship and creativity, it is important to ensure the "most-visible" public representation of this institution (our NMSU web presence) is easy to navigate and effectively conveys important information for prospective students, donors, and visitors. This must be done while also mitigating cybersecurity risk and ensuring legal requirements in privacy and web accessibility are met.

The target date for migration of the selected sites is July 2020. The NMSU community will be notified of migration timelines and training opportunities for website administrators throughout this process. More information about this transition can be found at nmsu.edu/cascade-migration.
